ANNUNAKI no speed to far turn with a mild improvement late stretch. LOUVAR saved ground throughout, close up far turn with no late punch. BLUE OPAL unhurried to the stretch with no response when needed. BENET never a factor from inside throughout. ELICIT good position to the half with nothing left and faded back. PICKLEBALL QUEEN slow start from the gate and always back. STORY CHANNEL tried to keep up for a half, gave in readily into far turn.
