## **Footnotes**

MCPHERSON chased the pace three deep around the turn, secured command entering the stretch, opened up in mid stretch and was kept to a drive. GEYSER, bumped by FLAT OUT MINE leaving the starting gate, was checked in tight quarters about a furlong after the break, worked between horses in the drive and closed gamely. LA MAQUINA GRIS, four wide on the turn, moved up to mid stretch, drifted in near the sixteenth pole and flattened out. HONEY DONT bumped with DETERMINED VISION leaving the starting gate, stalked the pace, was in striking position in the two path between horses leaving the turn and came up empty. FACT OF WAR saved ground on the turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch and lacked the necessary response. DETERMINED VISION bumped with HONEY DONT at the break, raced between horses on the turn, eased out to the six path in upper stretch and failed to rally. FLAT OUT MINE bore in bumping GEYSER at the break, showed speed two wide on the turn and gave way. AVAILABLE, fractious in the starting gate, raced wide on the turn, was fanned to the seven path in upper stretch and was not a factor. WILKO'S GOLDENEYE showed speed along the inner rail

and gave way the final furlong. BETTOR BANK ON IT, outrun, was fanned five wide turning for home.
