SWEET HOME DIXIE saved ground around the first turn, raced in the two path entering the far turn, eased out three wide leaving the bend, advanced outside horses, gained the lead approaching the sixteenth pole then drew clear under pressure. FANNIEBELLEFLEMING set a pressured pace along the rail and weakened late. FIDUCIARY VALUES prompted the pace two wide and tired. RAG TOP saved ground around the far turn, remained along the rail in the stretch and failed to rally. PETION LASS, five deep leaving the far turn, was not a factor. LANA, four wide both turns, was outrun. ALEXBABE, well placed two wide the far turn, gave way. TWO STEP SIS, always well off the inner rail, was outrun. PRIDE LEADER dropped back on the far turn.
