LEWISFIELD took over between rivals early on, set a rated pace towards the rail, was put to a drive in upper stretch, wandered outward a bit while clear near mid stretch, was corrected with right handed encouragement and prevailed. STILL HAVING FUN saved ground in range, eased out advancing a bit in upper stretch, shifted back in past the three sixteenths, closed gamely inside rivals and just missed. CLUBMAN stalked the pace three wide, moved closer into the lane, advanced between rivals past the sixteenth pole, kept on willingly but was out finished for the place. TACO SUPREAM broke inward then corrected and was taken to rate, commenced a run within himself leaving the far turn, circled five to six wide outside rivals entering the lane, ranged up in mid stretch but lacked the needed follow through. ALWAYSMINING had speed inside foes, rated back and angled out near the half mile marker, got out briefly leaving the far turn, was quickly righted and bid three deep nearing the lane, pursued four to five wide outside foes in mid stretch then faded. FEAR THE TURTLE, off the pace, raced removed from the rail into the lane, swung out late and had belated action. OLDIES BUT GOODIES forced the pace outside the winner, stayed on willingly to about the sixteenth marker then faded.
