

VIRGINIA BEACH edged up three to four wide nearing the half mile marker and tracked the leaders, came four wide for the drive, leveled off when switching over to her correct lead in mid stretch, forged to command heading to the sixteenth marker and held firm under a drive. DECO STRONG had speed to the inside of a pair of rivals, eased back off of those two nearing the turn and gave chase, angled out into the lane, moved up behind foes in mid stretch, altered to the rail for the final sixteenth, closed gamely and was getting to the winner. DETERMINED HEART broke a bit slow while rank, bumped with MONA LUNA soon after, moved up towards the leaders while about three wide, steadied back near three furlong marker, angled out, circled four wide into the lane, shifted out advancing past mid stretch, loomed and continued willingly. SEVILLA SANGRIA disputed the early pace between runners, vied inside a rival into the turn, chased while saving ground into the lane, shifted out and churned on to make a mild comeback. FULLMOON BAY vied outside SEVILLE SANGRIA while under early rating, shook clear past the five sixteenths, entered the lane three wide, drifted out a bit when collared past mid stretch and faded late. MONA LUNA broke slowly then bumped with DETERMINED HEART, moved up a bit between foes early on, angled four wide past the three eighths but lacked a further response. SICK SOCIETY saved ground pursuing the pace, stayed in touch for three furlongs then faded.
