ROARING RULE off the pace and the inside, two path turn, moved out three wide for the drive, closed with good resolve to be up in time. CHIEF OF STAFF vied early from between horses, dueled through the turn, garnered a slightly larger advantage past midstretch, just failed to hold the runner up safe while once again between horses at the wire. BUBBAS DIXIE off a step slow, lacked early foot, inside, continued to save ground when advancing late in the turn, challenged inside the runner up with a furlong remaining, outkicked by that rival and the winner to the wire. SUSPECT A STORM off slowly to spot the field a couple of lengths, raced back, two path into the lane, mild late interest while not a threat to the top three. GET THE BLING raced back and inside, continued to save ground into the stretch, altered course to the outside with a furlong remaining, improved slightly. SPEEDY DANSMERE broke sharp, vied early three wide, dueled through the turn, weakened in the drive. PLUMBAGO pinched then took up at the start, raced back in the three path, traffic, bothered a furlong out, remained back. HAMAZINGLY RICH within striking distance early, began to fade before a half. FLAT OUT MINE flashed brief speed along the inside, backed up.
