MARY'S JEWEL sped to a short early lead in the two path, dueled outside the winner from the half mile marker to mid stretch, failed to match strides from there but continued on with good effort to be well clear for the place. OLIVE KAT stalked the pace while saving ground, was under coaxing leaving the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch but lacked a rally. SARAH'S TREASURE pulled her way forward between runners early on, steadied briefly near the five and a half furlong marker, dropped back some leaving the far turn, angled out but failed to generate the needed run. BIRD TRAFFIC drafted back off the pace while saving ground, continued inside into and through the lane and offered a belated response. YOU MADE IT, well placed three wide stalking the dueling leaders, failed go on under a ride heading towards the lane and gave way. OUR STAR, three to four wide, failed to respond. LILO'S CALL broke slowly, was taken wide early and faltered leaving the far turn.
