QUEEN OF THE MESA had a slow start, swept past inner rivals with a four wide blitz into the turn, made a bid for the lead at the five sixteenths pole, and kicked away under driving pressure in upper stretch. TONIGHT MAYBE stalked in the two to three path, attempted a bid at the quarter pole, but was no match for the eventual winner in upper stretch, then edged place away from her inner foe at the sixteenth pole. RUSSIAN MELODY prompted the pace three wide, forged a slight lead at the five sixteenths pole, but was quickly hounded by QUEEN OF THE MESA, proved no match for that rival in upper stretch, dug in for place, but was edged out of that position at the sixteenth pole. LET'S GO DANZING chased the pace setters along the inside, but was shuffled back behind THREE POTATOE FOUR into the turn, shifted to the four path, and stayed on through the lane, but failed to threaten the leaders. THREE POTATOE FOUR dueled inside a pair of rivals early on, but failed to keep pace with them into the turn, and weakened. PRINGIPESSA had a slow start, trailed while staying in the four path through the turn, and was no factor. DECOLLETE dueled between horses early on, but weakened at the five sixteenths pole, resented the kick back once behind rivals at the quarter pole, and subsequently stopped through the lane.
