SHESHED close from the start off the inside, ranged up to challenge the leader from the outside midway on the turn, shook clear when straightened for home, maintained a daylight advantage past the furlong marker, held the runner up safe late. PUNISH in the second flight toward the inside. in some traffic turning into the stretch, moved out slightly, roused, finished willingly to be getting to the winner late. OH MY OH broke out to bother an outer rival, was forwardly placed, raced three wide through the turn, also managed some gain late. MIZ NIGHTCAP broke alertly, shook clear early, dueled late in the turn inside the winner, could not keep up in the drive. VEGAN GOES BEST broke in and toward the back, lacked speed early, two to three wide in the turn, improved slightly into the lane then finished up evenly. TRACI'S GREELEY bothered to be off a bit slowly, moved up to race within striking distance early while outside, four wide through the turn, had little left for the drive. HALEYS HEIST was never a threat while saving ground.
