BLENDED LUTE well placed early from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, angled outside for the drive, responded and was along in time. SPECTACTICAL forced the early pace from the inside, remained forward for the drive but could not match strides. TALK GRUFF chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the turn and rallied late for the show. BERNARDIAN chased the early pace inside but had no late response. CAT ADDICTION was no factor. COOLJOE was no threat. FLAT OUT MINE broke sharp from the outside, gained the early margin, remained clear through the turn then gave way.
