Footnotes

A BEAUTIFUL DAY tucked in behind the leaders for nearly six furlongs, was guided out three wide for clearance at the top of the stretch, caught HALFY from outside a sixteenth out, and edged SUBTLE JOY to the wire. SUBTLE JOY bumped lightly with ALL AMERICAN JEWEL at the start, stayed close between horses early, remained covered up and in some traffic nearing the quarter-pole, swung four wide and closed gamely outside the winner. BETTIN ONNA KITTEN was outrun for six furlongs, cut the corner advancing into the lane, got steered off the rail with a furlong remaining and was gaining too late outside the top two. ALL AMERICAN JEWEL bumped lightly with SUBTLE JOY at the start, steadied slightly inside going to the first turn, improved mildly awaiting room on the rail around the far turn, came to the two-path straightening away, moved back to the fence and rallied through tight quarters. HALFY pressed the pace outside SYLLABUS, took over after six furlongs, edged clear turning for home, but gave way through the late stages overrun from both

sides. NATIONALIST raced four wide into the first turn before moving in a bit, idled lacking a response three wide on the far turn, and went by tired horses after the fact. DELIA'S PRIDE raced four wide on the turns, and lacked a rally. MALAGA raced in or near the two-path much of the way, and failed to menace. SYLLABUS set the early pace inside, and retreated once displaced for command on the far turn. DAMA DE NOCHE was floated out to the five-path outside NATIONALIST early, moved up on the far outside up the backstretch, and was finished after six furlongs. AMERICAN COUNTESS raced three wide and was all done after a half-mile.
