PROUDLY FOUGHT quickly established a clear advantage, took the turn along the inside, then widened in upper stretch when asked for run, and was driven to the wire. CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR was forwardly placed along the inside, rated into the turn allowing another rival to clear off in the place position, shifted three wide turning for home to be outside of the leaders, and produced a grinding rally through the lane. BIZBY cleared inner and outer rivals to forge place into the turn, chased the loose leader around that bend, then weakened in deep stretch but held show. MESANGE chased the loose leader in the three to four path around the turn, then finished evenly. IT'S ALL CASH broke in and bumped a foe at the start, raced far off of the pace in the four to five path around the turn, came into the lane in the six path and widest of all, then produced a mild rally while shifting inwards through the lane. ANNOULA took a bump from her outer rival at the start, saved ground while far off of the pace, improved position in upper stretch, but failed to sustain a rally and flattened out. COCO CABALLO was pushed from the four to the five path around the turn and failed to menace. SUPREME IRENE was off slowly after lunging inwards at the start, raced far off of the pace in the two to three path and never got involved. REAL LATE trailed in the three path and was no factor. APRIL ENTRY three to four path, weakened into the turn. CALIKA ROSE saved ground, but weakened. FLAME OF ALBERTA was forwardly placed three wide, but rapidly faded passing the five sixteenths pole, and stopped.
