## Footnotes

IT'S THE JOURNEY prompted the early pace about five wide, moved to command three deep into the turn, kicked clear mid turn, opened up into the lane wandered outward from left handed rousing then was fully extended to prevail between runners. SIR DOUGLAS lagged off the pace while off the inside,
swung eight wide for the drive, made a grinding run and just missed. CAMPARI rated off the pace and removed from the inside, edged up outside foes mid turn, angled seven wide into the lane, advanced between runners near the sixteenth marker, dove inside as the winner drifted and finished gamely. IN HIM WITH HIM chased four wide outside rivals leaving the far turn, saw the winner get away past the three eighths, came back a bit near mid stretch but failed to seriously follow through. PRIME TIME MAN settled off the pace about three wide, angled six wide and a made a run into the lane, chased then flattened out. MYSTERIO, three wide between foes giving chase, angled in and lacked a bid. NARROW ESCAPE bobbled a bit at the break, regrouped to be close up, was lightly shuffled past the five eighths, angled out mid turn but failed to threaten. TOP HAT WARRIOR prompted the pace, bid inside foes nearing the turn, chased and gave way. A TRUE GENTLEMAN broke slowly, lagged off the pace, angled off the inside near the three sixteenths and failed to rally. BLAME THE KIDS, inside foes chasing past the five eighths, gave way. PEP TALKING, keen between runners early, gave way. GREEK GOD rushed up to clear early, set the pace well off the inside, dropped down nearing the turn, lost the lead after a half mile and faltered.
