ECHO OF VICTORY tracked the pace inside, tipped out in upper stretch, seized command in midstretch and drew off under a drive. LA SILUETA lacked early speed while saving ground, steadied midway around the turn, angled four wide nearing the lane and rallied widest to gain the place. OLD LINE MAGIC raced off the pace two wide between foes down the backstretch, angled to the rail early on the turn, angled back out in upper stretch and rallied between foes. TAPDANCING GIRL raced off the pace inside, tipped out in upper stretch and finished willingly between foes. PRINCESS ROSIE raced in range two

wide and flattened out in the final furlong. WEEKEND DELIGHT lagged well back inside, angled out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. LIVE AID set a clear pace along the rail to midstretch and caved. BOTTLE COURAGE was outrun while racing three and four wide. QUEEN OF TOMORROW played no factor while racing three wide. LOOKIN FOR CANDY raced two wide in midpack, lightly steadied in upper stretch and lacked a rally. NO SUGAR NO CREAM was fractious in the gate, broke slowly, was bit rank early, advanced three and four wide around the turn then tired in the lane. ROCKIN ANNA ROLLIN stalked the pace two wide in the clear and retreated through the lane.
