BIG BOOTS saved early ground then eased outward into the backstretch, started a four wide bid approaching the five sixteenths pole and took a slim lead two deep midway on the far turn, dueled clear mid-stretch and held on well under steady urging. SILVER CASTLE raced hemmed in at the rail rounding the opening turn then settled off the pace into the backstretch, steadied leaving the three eighths pole, started a bid from the five sixteenths, rounded the far turn off the rail and dug in to take second the final yards. NO REGRETS came through the opening turn about the four path and moved to the front three wide approaching the five sixteenths pole, drew clear toward the quarter, but was caught at the rail midway on the far turn, continued a close factor through the upper stretch then dropped back a sixteenth away and flattened later yards. CARTER'S RUN rounded the first turn in the five path and raced well off the pace outside into the backstretch, bid leaving the three eighths pole, came through the far turn in the five path then flattened stride the final furlong. ONCE MORE EH stalked the early pace two deep then challenged toward the seven sixteenths pole, and dueled between horses to the five sixteenths before fading. STRIVE FOR A CURE was hustled up to take the lead leaving the three quarter pole and rated the pace, came under pressure nearing the seven sixteenths, was caught toward the five sixteenths and gave way at the rail rounding the far turn.
