Footnotes

SHAMROCK KID settled off the earlier pace in the two and three paths the first turn then stalked into the backstretch, took the lead past the three eighths pole, raced clear into the far turn and proved much the best under steady handling. THE IRON BANK raced off the pace in the three and four paths then bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, came through the far turn in the five path, dug in leaving the turn and reached second the final yards. HOBE SOUND saved ground off the early pace then eased out into the backstretch, bid toward the seven sixteenths pole, raced in the four path of the far turn then ceded second the final yards. LION LORD pressured the pace three wide through the front stretch and took a slim lead past the half mile pole, was caught leaving the three eighths but continued chase to the quarter pole, dropped back from that point then weakened the final furlong. CAPE LOOKOUT was hustled along to set the early pace, headed into the backstretch and gave chase from that point, but dropped back leaving the three eighths pole and weakened at the rail on the far turn. FORTY FATHOMS pressured the pace through the front stretch and continued to give chase through the backstretch but faded into the far turn.
