SOUND OFF raced well back inside the first turn then eased out into the backstretch, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole and improved steadily in the six path of the far turn, raced outside entering the stretch and dug in to take the nod through the final yards. SHAMROCK KID stalked the pace about the three path, bid nearing the three eighths pole and raced at a close disadvantage three wide on the far turn, drifted into the stretch, dug in for a slim lead mid-stretch but was caught in the final strides. HOBE SOUND stalked the early pace from the three and four paths, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole and raced in the four path of the far turn then dug in to take third the final strides. LION LORD stalked the pace two deep, picked up the chase nearing the five sixteenths pole and raced at even terms while two deep and between horses through the far turn, was caught inside the sixteenth pole and flattened stride later yards. KING MAURO raced well back about the four path the first turn and left the turn outside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn in the six path and finished well. SINGANOTHERSONG rated the pace inside, came under pressure past the three eighths pole and was met at even terms nearest the rail midway on the far turn, contested the edge through the upper stretch, but weakened inside the sixteenth pole. GIO DUDE saved ground and bid only mildly leaving the seven sixteenths pole. THE WAYNE FACTOR was not a factor. SCHLOSSER checked from tight quarters early and raced in the five path the first turn, then showed little response after the opening half mile.
