## **Footnotes**

HE'S MEANT TO BE outrun in the early going off the inside, moved out to be five wide into the stretch, set down when straightened for home, kicked down the leader under firm handling. ACE DESTROYER away in good order, asked early to contest the pace into the turn, alternated up front while closest to the inside through the bend, disposed of the other speed to be clear when straightened for home, could not contain the winner while holding sway for the place. TENTWELVEFOURTEEN lacked early foot, remained back into the turn, steadied from between horses late in the bend, moved out widest for the drive, finished well while too late down the middle of the strip. BITUMEN broke a step slow, raced back toward the inside, moved out turning for home, improved with some mild interest out in the strip. SHARP ART in the second flight while racing outside, four wide into the turn, three wide exiting, had little left for the run to the wire. UNSCATHED settled behind the pace along the inside, continued to save ground out of the turn, failed to muster a closing response. DRILL'S LI'L MAN in the second group early while off the inside, steadily faded. KITCHEN FIRE broke alertly, dueled up front off the inside, gave way in the drive.
