UNCUT took over approaching the three quarter pole and angled to the inside to rate a clear pace, came under pressure nearing the three eighths, rounded the far turn at the rail and dug in under steady encouragement to hold off the late advance of OLD LINE MAGIC, who settled off the pace inside the opening turn then eased outward into the backstretch, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole and improved four wide on the far turn, dug in from the top of the stretch and was gaining steadily on the winner. UPSY DAISY DO saved ground off the pace, bid from the seven sixteenths pole and raced near the rail on the far turn, but flattened stride inside the eighth pole. FINDER ANGEL R V F raced off the pace in the two and three paths, picked up the chase from the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn two deep then flattened stride. JEAN GREY raced in the four and five paths the opening turn and left the turn outside, rounded the far turn about the three path and passed rivals in the lane. BLAZING BOURBON rounded the first turn about the four path, bid nearing the three eighths pole, came through the far turn in the seven path and showed little more. IRISH FIX rounded the first turn in the five path and stalked into the backstretch, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then weakened three wide on the far turn.
