REASON TO SOAR in the second group while toward the inside early, closer late turn, angled out four wide turning for home, extended drive, fully extended to hold the runner up at bay late. ALEXANDROS broke out, was straightened to race forwardly, closer three wide turn, lost some to the early leader into the lane, rebid nearing the furlong marker, came back for the place late in a determined effort. P R RADIO STAR lacked speed while off the inside, came three wide into the lane, rallied through traffic while altering course to be up late for the show. HIDDEN RULER void of speed while racing along the inside, continued to save ground turn, improved past the furlong marker, nipped in the final strides for the show. UNDERCOVER LOVER in the second group while outside the winner, floated out five wide by that one turning for home, lacked a closing kick. ACE DESTROYER broke alertly, cleared to the inside, showed the way through the turn, headed nearing midstretch, weakened when headed the final furlong. HUBBADAHUBBADABOOM away in good order, pressed the issue while between rivals in the turn, gave way in the drive.
