STONE SECRET off the pace while racing outside, five wide into the turn, ranged up four wide to challenge late in the turn, shook clear nearing the furlong ground, enough left under a firm right handed crop to last. CONFESS behind the first flight, prompted that group into and through the turn, lacked room exiting the bend, dropped to an open rail in upper stretch, finished willingly up the rail to be getting to the winner. ACE GILFORD broke alertly, vied up front in the run up the backstretch, continued to contest the issue through the turn, weakened a bit when unable to match strides with the top two, saved the show late. TOIL AND TROUBLE last away, raced back and three wide early, swung out five wide into the lane, improved position to be gaining for the show. HANEY BOYS in the second flight while racing four wide, came five wide into the lane, went evenly through the stretch. SQUARED STRAIGHT with the pace closest to the inside, vied through the turn, was tiring when bothered midstretch, continued to weaken. SCYNTZ set or forced the pace while widest of the first group, gave way entering the stretch, drifted in midstretch and continued to weaken. THAT DUDE remained back while racing just off the inside.
