DAIGLE, stalked just off the first flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out three wide nearing the far turn advancing to challenge, came inwards a bit crossing into the path of LOYAL AND TRUE approaching the three furlong marker, continued with a steady bid to wrest the advantage racing into upper stretch and was kept to firm encouragement. LOYAL AND TRUE tracked just off DAIGLE along the inside as part of the second flight into the backstretch, shifted out after a half gaining position between rivals, was forced inwards by DAIGLE racing past the three eighths marker crossing into the path of PERFECT SPRING while appearing to clip heels with that rival, continued with a steady advance while tipping out three wide racing into the stretch and proved best of the others. COUGER was urged forcing the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, angled to the inside entering the far turn disputing the issue inside a rival to upper stretch and gave out leaving midstretch. BAILDON settled outside foes racing three wide to the backstretch and

continued to make steady progress in that path to gain some position in late stages. NOTE PAD tracked off the second flight three wide to the backstretch, shifted inwards after a half, lost some momentum when steadying while jumping a fallen rival racing into the far turn, then angled to the inside and finished evenly in the drive. CARRILLO STREET, reserved off the second flight along the inside, switched out after a half to race three deep into the far turn but faded between foes racing into the lane. SWEET HOLINESS tracked the leaders outside foes in second flight racing to the backstretch and emptied out after a half. PRINCESS RENEE was settled outside a rival in the last flight to the backstretch, was taken up sharply avoiding stricken foes racing into the far turn, was outdistanced nearing the lane but walked off the course under her own power. METAPHAR settled along the inside racing as part of the last flight to the backstretch, fell over a fallen rival racing past the three furlong maker but was recovered by the outrider and walked off the course under her own power. PERFECT SPRING was urged to the lead along the inside disputing the pace into the backstretch, weakened after a half, clipped heels nearing the three furlong marker when caught in tight quarters dislodging her rider, but was collected by the outrider and walked off the course under her own power. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT NEAR THE THREE FURLONG MARKER AND DISQUALIFIED DAIGLE FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HER LAST.
