GET ONE MORE, bumped by GIO'S LIL ANGEL, then shuffled a bit at the start while exchanging some contact with CSILLA, pulled her way to a position just off the pacesetter between foes, was wrangled to the inside to track the leaders under rating to the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch, altered course back to the rail leaving the three sixteenths marker to bid for command inside the pacesetter, took a few awkward steps while drifting under correction in the closing stages but edged clear in time under pressure. JEWEL AZUL broke readily, angled to the inside dictating the pace on a narrow advantage to the far turn, shifted to the two path in upper stretch resisting several challengers but yielded to the winner late. GIO'S LIL ANGEL broke outwards bumping GET ONE MORE, shifted out of close quarters racing to the first turn to track off the first flight between, was urged to advance while shifting out three wide entering the lane but had no final kick after his rider lost his whip in the drive. CSILLA exchanged bumps at the start, was righted to track off the first flight outside rivals racing to the backstretch, made brief progress to advance on the leaders three wide nearing the far turn, was fanned five wide into the lane and steadily faded. ULTRA CORDIAL angled inwards while prompted to forward placing racing to the first turn, prompted the pacesetter between foes to the second bend, drifted out nearing upper stretch and gave way.
