WILLING TO BURN, forwardly placed stalking just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, gained position along the rail nearing upper stretch, then came through inside foes to edge GIVEITSOMEWELLIE in time under firm encouragement. The latter, off slowly, was prompted to make a steady gain between foes racing through the backstretch, drew into striking distance nearing upper stretch while shifting out four wide, then continued willingly in that path to just



miss. WESTERN BERLIN, urged inside foes disputing the pace from the outset to the far turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch and weakened late. NORTH OF EDEN settled in the last flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily gathered momentum switching off the inside nearing the far turn, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve position. LILA'S LUCKY LADY settled outside foes, was fanned five wide into the lane and passed tiring rivals. MISS BROOKSIDE settled along the inside early, saved ground to the lane and made some belated progress inside foes. DUSTY PRINCESS settled last racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. TEQUILA MARY switched out three wide tracking the leaders in second flight to the far turn, then faded into the stretch. EVERYBODY DOES IT worked her way to the inside early but offered no rally. SILVERA, urged between foes prompting the pace from the outset to the far turn, gave way midstretch. DOUBLE BEE STING was urged three wide backstretch and retreated early.
