MISSION TRAIL broke awkwardly and was steadied, quickly recovered and moved up between horses into contention, then three wide, made a strong run on the turn, rallied to the front passing the quarter pole, drew clear and then held on late. GONE DREAMING chased two wide, chased on the turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and was gaining late. DARESCA raced off the pace between rivals, rode the rail into the stretch, angled out and rallied mildly. DUSTINTHEWIND was outrun early and closed belatedly for a share. BETTER BOAT showed good early speed to set the pace, dueled with the winner briefly passing the quarter pole, then weakened. NO SYMPATHY was off slowly, raced off the pace inside and failed to threaten. SIPN DIP bobbled at the break, chased inside and faded. THAWED chased three wide and faded. FIRST TO TEA raced off the pace inside and gave way.
