BIG FALCON ROCKET broke well then moved forward quickly to dictate the pace on the inside, continued on a measured advantage into the far turn then kicked to a clear lead at the furlong marker while under steady right-handed pressure and dug in during the final sixteenth to prevail on the wire. JOHAN ZOFFANI (IRE) was caught three wide in the first flight on the opening bend, continued just off the early pacesetters down the backstretch then commenced a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole, altered course nearing the furlong marker to avoid DAIGLE and finished willingly late but just missed. EDGIE REGGIE broke well then attended the pace three wide early, continued just off the leader into the far turn, roused at the three eighths and finished willingly late to hold third place. ROBINSON was far back in the early going, angled out eight wide at the three sixteenths pole and rallied belatedly in the lane to get up for fourth. WHERE'S JORDAN was reserved in the early stages, roused to improve past the three eighths pole, angled out six wide off the far turn, forced out nearing the eighth pole and was outkicked late. TRADE DEADLINE tracked the early pace between foes, well positioned entering the far turn but had no late kick. TRI SPOT was reserved inside throughout, saved ground to the top of the stretch and had no late rally. SOUL READY was unhurried well back through the half, angled out on the far turn and passed tiring foes. DAIGLE attended the early pace on the outside, asked for run nearing the three eighths and had no bid in the lane while weakening to the wire. YAK chased the pace on the rail and gave way in the lane. CAPTAIN DRAKE pressed the pace between foes in the second flight early and failed to respond when asked and leveled off in the lane. EBONY BAY settled outside early, made a brief attempt to get into contention into the far turn and had no late bid past the quarter pole. WACO KID showed brief foot, dropped to the rear and was eased in the lane.
