## **Footnotes**

SAILING ALONG was rated off the first flight along the inside racing to the turn, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to narrowly prevail in time under firm handling. SHE BEGAN AGAIN, off slowly, was settled last along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and was going well inside rivals in the closing stages to just miss. BIRDIE BE GONE, bumped at the start, was urged three deep between foes pursuing the pacesetter into the turn, moved to terms challenging for command between foes in that path midstretch but proved no match for the top pair late. FABLES LOVE AFFAIR, raced unhurried between foes in the second flight in early stages, angled out five wide racing into the lane and continued with a mild bid. A ROZE AND WINE, urged between foes dictating the pace on a narrow advantage in early stages, pressed the issue outside a rival through the turn and gave out once headed leaving midstretch. ORNAMENTAL IRON, urged inside foes prompting the pace from the outset into the turn, dueled for command to upper stretch and gave out. BAILDON, bumped at the start, settled outside foes racing to the turn and failed to menace. PRETTY SWEET, restless in the gate in an incident that required the field to be reloaded, proved no factor. H'RAYFORCABERNEIGH made brief pursuit of the leaders four wide on the backstretch, angled inwards nearing the turn and soon retreated. THE RACE WAS DELAYED FOR SEVERAL MINUTES WHEN A ROZE AND WINE REQUIRED A SUBSTITUTE RIDER AFTER THE ORIGINALLY NAMED RIDER SUFFERED AN INJURY IN A GATE MISHAP.
