FAIR CATCH bore out leaving the starting gate, showed speed, saved ground around the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and lasted. SOUTH SEA , forced out by the winner leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the turn stalking the pace, had ample room along the inner rail in mid stretch, altered course to the five path near the sixteenth pole and closed late. OLDIES BUT GOODIES, forced leaving the starting gate, stalked the pace three deep on the turn, raced on his left lead in the stretch and flattened out. ROBEY'S BOY trailed to mid stretch, raced outside foes in the drive and found his best stride late. FIZBO, pinched back leaving the starting gate, swung to the four path leaving the turn and lacked the necessary rally. BACKWOODS BOOGIE , three deep on the turn, failed to rally. DUBINI raced in the two path between horses on the turn and came up empty in the stretch. MR. EDGAR hugged the inner rail and weakened. BULL SHARK showed speed outside the winner and faltered in the stretch.
