GOLD WING, reserved along the inside racing into the turn, saved ground through the turn, gained position gathering momentum inside foes nearing midstretch, tipped off the inside and produced a solid late response to surge past I KICKN in time to prevail under pressure. The latter angled inwards in early stages to force the pace outside a rival through the backstretch into the turn, edged forward to a clear advantage leaving midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner. HOT AND HEAVY, urged inside a rival disputing the pace from the outset to the stretch, yielded leaving the furlong marker while prevailing for a share. FIVE STAR CREEK tracked off the first flight along the inside racing to the turn, was prompted to advance nearest the rail approaching the stretch, then shifted out racing through the lane but had no rally. MR. EDGAR was rated off the second flight racing to the turn, angled out in upper stretch but had no closing bid. SUNSHINE CHARLIE tracked off the first flight outside a rival racing to the turn, shifted out three deep racing into the lane, but steadily faded. SOURCESANDMETHODS was off slowly and trailed throughout.
