HARDLY A SECRET unhurried for five furlongs, moved strongly to the front while three wide and between rivals turning for home, quickly clear, won geared

down to win ridden out. EAGLE PASS in tight at the start, raced well back for five furlongs as well, fanned six wide into the lane, rallied for the place while not a threat to the winner. KIERKEGAARD away in good order, dueled up front along the inside, held a slight advantage late in the final turn, offered little resistance to the winner when that one took over into the lane, chased that same rival past the furlong marker, caught late for the place. THAT'S WHAT I SAY lacked speed, encountered some traffic in the far turn off the inside, was floated five wide into the stretch, displayed a mild amount of late interest. SPLASH FOR GOLD brushed at the start, settled in mid pack while toward the inside, continued in the two path into the far turn, moved inside midway on the final bend, lacked a serious closing response when called on for the drive. SLICK SILVER off the pace and the inside, four out to five wide in the second turn, lacked a rally. GAMBLER raced in the second flight while off the inside, had little left for the drive. PRIVATE LAKE four wide in the first turn when with the main body, continued outside, weakened through the stretch. KING FORD brush at the start, raced back off the pace and the inside, two path second bend, failed to muster a rally. JACK'S ADVANTAGE dueled up front off the inside, continued to alternate up front the middle half, gave way turning for home. ANDREAS off a step slow, dropped inside to save ground, was never a factor. KNIGHT'S CROSS in the second flight while moving just off the inside first turn, stopped second turn, jogged in.
