D DAWG broke readily, was rated tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing into the turn, made a steady advance on that foe to wrest the advantage in the three path racing into upper stretch, then made the balance of the place under energetic handling to prove best. HENNI PENNY ducked out at the start, then was held up out of close quarters settling last on the backstretch, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to prevail for the place honors nearing the wire. CATIRUSIA tracked just off the eventual winner three deep racing through the backstretch into the turn, angled four wide approaching upper stretch while advancing to challenge but lacked the needed final kick while edging a rival for a share. CSILLA switched off the inside in early stages tracking off the second flight three deep between foes, was roused to advance while angling to the inside in the last furlong but was outkicked for a share. J'S SILKY angled to the inside tracking the leader just behind the eventual winner racing to the turn and faded into upper stretch. MISS MARGARET ANN sprinted clear of the field remaining well off the rail racing into the turn but was spent nearing upper stretch.
