Footnotes

JOE PHILLIPS was rated off the first flight along the inside to the far turn, tipped outside the pacesetter nearing upper stretch and wrested a clear advantage in time under firm handling. WHISKEY PLANK, urged inside rivals disputing the pace, edged forward racing into the far turn, resisted the winner's bid to midstretch but proved only second best. MR. COUGAR tracked the leaders between foes in second flight, angled four wide nearing upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for a share. TURN THE SWITCH, urged three wide prompting the pace from the outset to the far turn, faded into upper

stretch. LIGHT CRUISER, held up out of tight quarters early, settled along the inside, saved ground to the lane and improved position while no real threat. EDGIE REGGIE, reserved off the second flight while angling inwards to the backstretch, gained position between rivals racing through the far turn but had no late bid. TOUR THE WORLD, reserved along the inside early, angled four wide entering the stretch but made no impact. WHERE'D THE DAY GO tracked the leaders three wide in second flight to the backstretch and faded after a half. VIOLIN MAKER, caught four wide between foes to the backstretch, retreated early. ELUSIVE FREUD, urged between foes pressing the pace, gave way on the far turn. TWILITE LIASON, caught five wide racing to the backstretch, dropped out early. SHINBORO proved no factor.
