GLOSSY MADRINA tracked the pace four wide and came five wide into the lane and was slowly gaining late. LEFTATTHEALTAR was off a step slow, settled back four wide, came six wide into the lane, lugged in through the stretch, was in traffic leaving the furlong marker and closed well between rivals late. BRIDGE TO BROOKLYN was reserved early, advanced three wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane and had a late rally. CAPE COD SALLY set a pressured pace on the inside and gave way grudgingly. DANCE A LITTLE JIG was allowed to settle early and saved ground on the turn and then had a belated rally on the inside. PARABLE was bumped at the five eighths marker, tracked the pace on the inside and faded in the drive. MORRIGAN was fractious ion the gate, off slowly and showed little.
