THEALLIGATORHUNTER was urged inside foes disputing the pace from the outset into the bend, edged forward nearing midstretch and went clear late under firm left handed encouragement. BLAME J D was rated off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the turn, steadily advanced on the leaders nearing upper stretch to split foes three wide approaching the furlong marker but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving best of the others. BRING ME A CHECK was urged pressing the pace outside the eventual winner through the backstretch into the turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. BUGLER tracked off the first flight outside foes in early stages, was prompted to advance four wide racing into the turn to briefly gain striking distance nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. SIR WELLINGTON lost his footing at the start, breaking very awkwardly losing position to the field, settled into stride a bit off the inside racing into the bend, angled inside entering the stretch but made no real impression. PRINCE RAMA, forwardly placed three wide in the opening stages racing just off the first flight, was urged to press the issue between foes into the bend and gave way after a half. EUROMANTIC angled to the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance but retreated early.
