## **Footnotes**

READY TO FLY stalked close up two wide, bid two wide at the half mile marker, dueled inside on the far turn, led into the stretch, dug in gamely inside of RISING MOON in the final furlong, exchanged bumps with that rival and prevailed at the wire. RAISING MOON broke outward and bumped a rival at the start, raced four wide into the first turn, moved up four wide at the half mile marker, bid three wide on the far turn, dueled with READY TO FLY, dug in gamely outside of that rival, exchanged bumps in the final furlong and battled to the finish. GOD IS LOVE was bumped at the start, raced off the early pace, moved up three wide at the half mile marker, made a bid, chased the leaders on the far turn and dug in for third in the stretch. SIR SAFFER raced off the pace inside, then between rivals, moved up three wide on the far turn and gained mildly outside. LARGER THAN LIFE bobbled at the break, raced three wide early, continued three wide off the pace, went four wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. FOOD BANK HELPER raced two wide off the pace, came two wide into the lane and failed to threaten. HELLMAN raced off the pace inside, was shuffled back behind a tiring runner on the far turn, continued on the rail and lacked a rally. GUN FOR SUCCESS pulled in the early stages on the rail, then tracked inside, chased on the far turn and faded. ITS OVER set the pace on the inside, dueled briefly on the backside and gave way on the far turn. A Trainer's Objection by the runner up against the winner was dismissed.
