PASSTHECAT broke readily, was urged to the lead while angling inwards to set the pace just off the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled for command between foes into the far turn, disputed the issue in a protracted skirmish outside a rival past midstretch but edged forward late under strong handling. ITWASTHEDEVILSIDEA angled to the rail in early stages stalking just inside the pacesetter to the backstretch, advanced inside that foe to press the issue racing into the far turn, continued in a prolonged drive while shifting off the inside racing into the lane and was outkicked in the final sixteenth. PIRATE BIRD settled along the rail tracking off the second flight to the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch and continued with interest to gain a share. BOOTLEGGIN POSSE, pulling against light rating while gaining a forward placing three wide racing to the backstretch, moved to lodge a brief bid in that path after a half but emptied out nearing upper stretch. BIG BOY MCCOY settled outside foes in the last flight to the backstretch, lost some ground to the leaders racing to the far turn, angled to the rail racing through the stretch but made no real impression. TIGER HUNTER tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, shifted out four wide midway through the backstretch while being prompted to gain some position but emptied out abruptly entering the far turn.
