BLO MY BUDGET was allowed to settle early, made a inside move on the turn, took over leaving the turn and shifted out, then held sway late to prove best under a drive. SASSY LAD pressed the pace three wide, then stalked the pace four wide by the quarter pole, then finished willingly to the wire, second best. SIBERIAN chased the pace and was two to three wide on the turn, then made a inside bid leaving the three sixteenths but needed more. NAZARENO was reserved early three wide, then dropped to the inside by the quarter pole, angled out sharply nearing the furlong marker, and had no kick. YANKEE EMPIRE set a pressured pace early, then shook clear on the turn and was three w2ide by the quarter pole and weakened. ADY'S MUNNY stalked the pace four wide and then was five wide by the quarter pole and came up empty. Due to a power surge the final margins at the finish were provided by the writer of these notes for this race.
