LADY COMMANDER broke in but alertly, set or forced the pace in the two path, shook clear into lane, maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire without feeling the whip to win ridden out. NO GUILT in mid pack early, moved closer then steadied just before a half, fell back a bit, chased the winner into the stretch in the two path, made minimal inroads on that one late, clearly second best. AMENSET steadied near the back into the first turn, closer before a half off the inside, came four wide for the drive when mounting a mild rally to finish up best of the rest. INTO DISCO in mid pack after angling to the rail first turn, firm in hand while surrounded in the run up the backstretch, steadied in continued traffic far turn, went evenly to the wire after recovering. DIAL TONI within striking distance outside, advanced to race closest to the winner briefly with a three wide move second turn, failed to sustain that advance down the lane. BLAME THE TOLL lacked speed outside, four wide through the final turn, remained back in failing to rally. SHEZA CAT fell well back after the start, came four wide for the drive and continued to be well beaten. ELUSIVE BELLE restless in the gate prior to the start, was unloaded, broke with the field, set or forced the pace for five furlongs, stopped far turn, distanced, walked in.
