**Footnotes**  
LUCID saved ground around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, came around the second bend in the two and three path, launched a bid passing the quarter pole and got up for the win late. CESAR raced in the two path around the first bend, chased the leader on the outside up the backstretch, challenged from the three path coming around the far turn and dueled in the stretch, getting caught near the wire. SUMMER ALL YEAR led the field while saving ground around the first turn and up the backstretch, dueled from the rail around the far bend and weakened in the final furlong. ROCK CHALK raced in the middle of the pack on the inside through the opening half mile, navigated the far turn from the two path and was outkicked in the lane. COX CANYON trailed the field while saving ground around the first turn and up the backstretch, dropped back further while racing in the three path around the second bend and was never a factor.
