MR JACK led the way from the three path around the first turn and up the backstretch, continued around the second bend in the two path and drew off in the lane, much the best. GRAPHENE CASSOCK raced in the four path around the first turn, chased the leader on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the far turn from the three path and kept on to the wire but was no match for the winner. GINETTES ON FIRE trailed the field while saving ground through the opening quarter of a mile, moved up to race in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, came around the far bend in the four path and finished evenly. FUNNY MAN raced off the pace on the inside through the opening half mile, continued around the second turn in the four path and was not a threat. CAJUN OCCASION raced in the two path early, continued up the backstretch in the middle of the pack on the outside, navigated the far turn still in the two path and never fired. SCHOOLMASTER (GER) raced in the two path around the first bend, tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the far turn and tired in the stretch.
