PLATINUM PROMISE was away alertly to set the pace while clear, was headed by the quarter pole, then ran on gamely but was outfinished by the winner, second best. TROPICALDEPRESSION broke in the air at the start and was far back early, advanced four to fiver wide on the turn, came six wide into the lane and had a belated rally to gain the show award. UNION RALLY steadied after the start, chased the pace and came three wide into the lane and needed a rally, missed show award. DEBBIE'S SURPRISE stalked the pace four wide and weakened. KNOT ANYMORE chased the pace on the inside, then checked leaving the half mile marker, got out badly on the turn and was eased thru the stretch, walked off.
