FOOD BANK HELPER steadied leaving the chute, raced off the pace inside, moved up on the far turn, came six wide into the lane, rallied outside, closed willingly in the final sixteenth and was up late for the win. BRAMBLE BLAZE raced off the pace inside, moved up two or three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the lane, rallied outside, dug in late and was just up for second. NINTH OF APRIL checked in tight leaving the chute, then moved up four wide on the first turn, stalked outside, bid three wide on the far turn, dueled, shook clear in upper stretch, dug in gamely and lost second at the wire. TRIPLE START pulled and was steadied entering the clubhouse turn, raced off the pace between rivals, came four wide into the lane and rallied mildly. HARD MISSION was bumped at the start, pulled on the inside, then tracked inside, chased on the far turn and lacked a rally. PLEASANT VALIANT raced off the rail, off the pace, angled out in the stretch and closed belatedly. BATTLE OF YORKTOWN was bumped at the start, set the pace on the inside, chased inside on the far turn and tired. CORE FACTOR raced four wide early, stalked three wide, bid, dueled two wide on the far turn and tired. GRAND MANNER steadied in the chute, vied two wide for the lead, dueled inside on the far turn and tired. HORSE DADDY was outrun.
