BEBOP BABY chased the top pair early on, raced three to four wide around the far turn and surged up from the outside under strong handling. WHERE'S FRANKIE dueled two path outside of foe, dug in and gave way grudgingly late while racing off the inside. BRAHMS IS WHO dropped back off the early going, moved up from the outside and closed in belatedly. CELTICS WILDCAT dueled along the rail and weakened the final eighth of a mile. BID ONCE was off slowly, rushed up from the inside and was empty in the drive. RABBIT TWENTY TWO bobbled at the break, hustled inside, lost ground and never threatened.
