BUGLER loomed boldly from mid pack along the backstretch, advanced on the pacesetter from a three path position through the turn, rated on even terms at upper stretch, dueled side by side and bested. RUNTODAY RUNTODAY rushed from outset and led the field into and through the turn while saving ground, then just missed the score after being outdueled in the final furlong. RUN LEA RUN settled into mid pack in the early stages, was shuffled back near end of backstretch, saved ground around the bend, and rallied mildly along the rail for the show. BIRDIE MACHINE hustled form outset and showed interest in early command, rated as the lone rival in second flight entering the turn, swung wide at upper stretch, then finished evenly. AMERICAN REFUGEE showed reserve from outset, trekked widest of all at upper stretch, and tired in closing strides. MONGOLIAN BEE gave chase to leaders from an inside stance, floated out at head of stretch to advance, but weakened in closing strides.
