Footnotes

BUCK WILD raced in the three path early, settled at the back of the pack on the inside for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the four path coming around the second turn and kicked clear. SYNONYM led the field from the two path through the opening half mile, continued around the second bend still in the two path, was caught near the quarter pole and chased on to the wire. MR BOLDACIOUS raced in the two path early, continued up the backstretch off the pace on the inside, came around the second turn in the four path and gained ground mildly in the lane. MIDNIGHT STRIKES raced in the two path around the first bend, tracked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and weakened in the stretch. LONG TOM raced in the three path at the back of the pack around the first turn and up the backstretch, continued around the far turn in the three path and made no bid. LUCID saved ground early, chased the leader up the backstretch, dropped back while saving ground around the far turn and continued to tire in the stretch.
