CAJUN OCCASION was three wide into the first turn, dropped to the inside and was well rated, made a two wide bid nearing the quarter pole, drew clear leaving the turn and widened the margin to prove much the best, driving. SPINNING MUSICIAN set the pace on the inside, headed by the quarter pole and proved to be no match for the winner while second best. WONDER WATER chased the early pace on the inside, fell back on the inside, shifted out and was three wide by the quarter pole, angled out to the outside and was along for the show award. BLUEBERRY MASH was settled back early, came four wide into the lane and had no rally. MERCURY TEN prompted the pace three wide for six furlongs and then weakened. SWEEPIN HARD chased the pace two wide and weakened.
