WHATTA NOTION advanced three wide into the turn taking the lead three furlongs from home, kicked away in upper stretch then held from a fast-charging rival. ABBY'S LUCKY GIRL was in tight at the start, settled at rear inside, shifted seven wide into upper stretch, was gaining but too late. BEST WORST IDEA bumped a rival at the start, was urged, chased two to three wide, was within range coming past the quarter pole, lacked the needed late kick. VIROLOGIST tracked from inside, came out a path midway on the turn to pass a tiring foe, kept on evenly. SPEIGHTS DELITE switched outside foes racing off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, fanned out five deep into upper stretch, evened out thereafter. SHORT OF DINERO failed to threaten while racing off the inside. VISUAL ILLUSION was bumped at the start, broke alertly, set the pace shifting nearer the rail, was overtaken at the three-eighths and faded thereafter.
