## Footnotes

ROMP was well rated two wide, made a five wide bid off the turn, lugged in nearing the sixteenth marker and then got up late to prevail under a drive, vanned off. TRIBAL NOTION was six wide into the first turn, prompted the pace four wide, made a four wide bid off the turn and dueled for command by the furlong marker, shook off that rival but could not hold off the winner to just miss. PRATT tracked the early pace on the inside, shuffled back on the backstretch, eased out on the turn and made a five wide bid off the turn and was gaining late. CAJUN OCCASION vied for the early lead, then was between rivals down the backstretch, then was on the inside by the quarter pole and faded late. SUPER DUDE tracked the pace five wide on the backstretch, then was four wide by the quarter pole, came six wide into the lane and had no kick. CRITICAL THINKING prompted the early pace three to four wide, then went up to vie for command three wide by the half mile marker, then was between rivals by the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. UNCLE YUDI was allowed to settle on the inside, came seven wide into the lane and had no bid. COPPERHEAD CREEK was away alertly to vie for the lead on the inside and weakened. PURPLE SHIRT was seven wide into the first turn, settled three wide and had no response.
