TOUGH ENOUGH raced in the five path the first turn then stalked from the half mile pole, challenged toward the three eighths, moved to even terms two deep midway on the far turn, drifted into the lane but dug in and dueled clear later yards. TRAVEL SMART exchanged light contact with Wicked Saucy shortly after the break then rated a short lead, came under pressure nearing the three eighths pole, was met at the rail midway on the far turn and remained a factor through the upper stretch before relenting. SKYLAR'S SISTER stalked from the three path, picked up the chase nearing the three eighths pole, raced in the three path on the far turn and ran evenly down the lane. DESTINED TO DANCE saved ground on the first turn, picked up the chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole, raced off the rail on the far turn and could only improve hear position. WHATTA NOTION settled in the three path the first turn, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the far turn about the four path and showed little further. THE MONEY MACHINE stalked from the three path the first turn, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole, raced at the rail on the far turn then weakened inside the eighth pole. ALWAYS FORWARD rounded the opening turn in the four path, left the turn outside and bid mildly from the three eighths pole and weakened in the six path the far turn. WICKED SAUCY exchanged light contact with Travel Smart soon after the start, rated close inside on the first turn, gave chase through the backstretch but weakened at the rail on the far turn.
