STASSI was well rated early two wide, shifted out leaving the five sixteenths and made a four wide bid nearing the quarter pole, took over leaving the turn and drew clear, then held on late to prove best, driving. CHARM ALARM was reserved early, three wide on the turn, came five wide off the turn and then was bumped by the furlong marker and then closed full of run but could not get to the winner, second best. MUSKOKA SUMMER was allowed to settle early, two wide on the turn, came four wide off the turn and then was bumped and in tight by the furlong marker, then got back into stride and finished willingly to gain the show award. CUT FROM CLASS was settled early, saved ground on the turn and made a mild bid off the turn on the inside but flattened out late. JACK'S LILLY was settled back early, came three wide into the lane and then was shut off and blocked and had to check hard by the furlong marker and then shifted out and had a belated rally. MAGIC BEAUTY pressed the early pace and made a inside bid by the quarter pole to duel for command but weakened in the drive. ANOTHERWORLDINSIDE was allowed to settle early, three wide entering the turn and dropped to be two wide off the turn, angled out and bumped a rival nearing the furlong marker and faded. COULD BE A COUGAR was fractious in the gate, set a pressured pace two wide and was headed by the quarter pole and then gave way in the drive. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND A TRAINER AND JOCKEY OF THE NUMBER EIGHT MUSKOKA SUMMER FILED OBJECTION AGAINST THE NUMBER SEVEN CHARM ALARM FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. AFTER REVIEWING THE REPLAYS THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THE OBJECTIONS AND LEFT THE RACE AS IS, DETERMINING THE NUMBER SIX CAUSED THE INTERFERENCE..
